

## 2022 TFUMC Youth Ski Trip Info

When: **Friday, February 18th - Monday, February 21st**

Where: **Wolf Ridge Ski Resort (Mars Hill, NC)**

Total Cost: **\$390.00/student\*, \$175.00/adult; \$100 non-refundable deposit required to secure slot**

\*cost to reflect 40 students in attendance

\*\*\*If you are unable to go on this trip due to financial constraints, please let me know!

### What's Included in the Cost:

- 3 nights lodging
- 2 day lift tickets
- 2 day ski or snowboard rentals
- 2 lunch vouchers at the ski resort
- Beginner Lessons (free as of now, but that is subject to change)
- All transportation
- All meals (except 2)

### Where are we staying? What are we eating?:

- **Our lodging is at Blue Ridge Assembly (Black Mountain, NC).** We have a lodge reserved that will have more than adequate space to house our group.
- We have a full kitchen available at the lodge, so all of our breakfasts and dinners will be eaten there. The food will be a little more simple (menu to come later), but we can very easily be more mindful of food allergies and dietary restrictions if we're able to keep an eye on what food and beverages we do/don't have on hand.
- The two lunches while we are in North Carolina (19th and 20th) will be covered by the lunch vouchers at the ski resort that we got with the group tickets.
- Lunch on travel days will be on the road (and not included in the cost of the trip), so students will need money for those 2 meals.

### Additional Costs:

- Two lunches (one on the way to NC and one on the way back to GA)
- Ski Bib Rental (\$30.00)
- Helmet Rental (\$20.00)
- Souvenirs

**\*\*\*The ski bib and helmet can either be rented, or students are allowed to bring their own to avoid that cost\*\*\***

#### **Equipment Rental:**

- **Ski and Snowboard rentals are included in the cost, so those will not be extra. However, if a ski bib and helmet need to be rented, that is an additional cost.**
- **Please note: Students can choose to either ski OR snowboard. There isn't an option to do both. So whatever the student chooses to do that weekend is what they are stuck with. Basically, unless you've been snowboarding before and know that you absolutely love it, it probably would not be wise to choose that.**

#### **What if I've never been skiing/snowboarding before?:**

- **As stated above, beginners lessons are available, and are an absolute must for those who haven't been skiing before, or those that haven't been in a long time and just want to brush up on the basics! As of now, the lessons are free, which sweetens the deal even more. If at any point there is a cost added to that by the resort, I will notify you as I get that information.**

#### **Payment Schedule:**

- **\$100.00 non-refundable deposit per student and adult (due on Monday, November 15th, 2021)**
- **Remaining \$290.00/student; \$75/adult (due on Wednesday, January 12th, 2022)**

**\*If the remaining payment can not be made by January 12th, 2022, then it will be assumed you cannot go on the trip, therefore, your spot on the trip is at risk of being lost. If there will be an issue of getting the payment in on time, please let Christian know ASAP.**

#### **Mandatory Meeting Date:**

- **Sunday, February 6th, 2022, in the YAC Theater.**
- **Important informational meeting - attendance by at least the student and/or 1 parent/guardian is required**
